## Out-of-Network Reimbursement Guide

Early Bird Speech Therapy PLLC is an **out-of-network provider** with insurance. We do, however, offer documentation (i.e., a *Superbill*) that clients can use when requesting reimbursement from your insurance. Please note that insurance companies vary, and speech-language therapy services may or may not be a covered benefit by your insurance. Therefore, we recommend contacting your insurance company with any questions you may have regarding your coverage. To assist you with receiving reimbursement, we have created this document to guide you in determining your out-of-network reimbursement benefits.

Reserve 15-30 minutes of your time to call your insurance company. Have the following information ready before your call:

- Insurance card
- Name, date of birth, address, phone number, or social security number of the child

The insurance representative may ask for the following information:

Questions to ask:

- Does my plan include out-of-network coverage for speech & language evaluations and treatment?
- Is there an annual deductible for out-of-network speech therapy? If so, how much?
- How much of my out-of-network deductible has already been met this year?
- Is there a limit on the number of sessions my plan will cover per year? If yes, how many?
- Is there a limit on out-of-pocket expenses per year?
- What CPT codes does my plan cover for speech therapy?
- Does my plan require pre-authorization and/or referral for speech therapy?
- Can I submit a Superbill? If so, what is the process for submitting a Superbill?
- What additional forms do I need to submit with a Superbill, if any?
- Do Superbills need to be submitted within a specific timeframe following sessions?
- How long does it take to process a claim?

Typical speech & language CPT codes

- 92523: Speech and language evaluation
- 92507: Speech therapy, individual
- 92521: Speech fluency (stuttering) evaluation
- 92610: Feeding evaluation
- 92526: Feeding therapy
- 92609: Therapeutic services for use of AAC device

Information to document before ending the call:

- Reference number for the call
- Name of customer service representative
- Date/time of call
